STATEMENT OF COMMON GROUND by English Heritage and Woking Borough Council

- 1. In order to bring it into conformity with the TCP (LB & CA) Act 1990 and PPS 5, CS20 shall be amended to remove the words 'where appropriate' from the first sentence of the second paragraph.
- 2. The Evidence Base (at 5.194) shall contain separate notice of the lists of statutorily listed buildings; the list of locally listed buildings; of conservation areas; of registered parks and gardens; of scheduled ancient monuments; and an indication of where the HER is kept and how it may be consulted.
- 3. In accordance with PPS 5 (HE 2.3 and HE 3.1) it is agreed that the Council will work proactively with all Stakeholders to ensure the conservation, enhancement and enjoyment of the historic environment, including identifying opportunities to mitigate and adapt to climate change where that will not harm the integrity of the heritage asset.
- 4. Outside the Core Strategy process, English Heritage urges the Council to implement (3) above by initiating a process of assessing the condition of its heritage assets by survey on a rolling programme.
